First Reading

Joshua 24: 1-2a, 14-18

- Then Joshua assembled all the tribes of Israel at Shechem. He summoned the elders, leaders, judges and officials of Israel, and they presented themselves before God.
- Joshua said to all the people, "This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: 'Long ago your ancestors, including Terah the father of Abraham and Nahor, lived beyond the Euphrates River and worshiped other gods.
- 14 "Now fear the Lord and serve him with all faithfulness. Throw away the gods your ancestors worshiped beyond the Euphrates River and in Egypt, and serve the Lord.
- ¹⁵ But if serving the Lord seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord."
- 16 Then the people answered, "Far be it from us to forsake the Lord to serve other gods!
- 17 It was the Lord our God himself who brought us and our parents up out of Egypt, from that land of slavery, and performed those great signs before our eyes. He protected us on our entire journey and among all the nations through which we traveled.
- And the Lord drove out before us all the nations, including the Amorites, who lived in the land. We too will serve the Lord, because he is our God."

Psalm 34: 12-22

L: Whoever of you loves life and desires to see many good days,

C: keep your tongue from evil and your lips from telling lies.

L: Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it.

C: The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous,

and his ears are attentive to their cry;

L: but the face of the Lord is against those who do evil, to blot out their name from the earth.

C: The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles.

- L: The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.
- C: The righteous person may have many troubles, but the Lord delivers him from them all;
- L: he protects all his bones, not one of them will be broken.

C: Evil will slay the wicked; the foes of the righteous will be condemned.

L: The Lord will rescue his servants; no one who takes refuge in him will be condemned.

Second Reading

Ephesians 5: 6-21

- Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of such things God's wrath comes on those who are disobedient.
- Therefore do not be partners with them.
- For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light
- (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth)
- and find out what pleases the Lord.
- Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them.
- 12 It is shameful even to mention what the disobedient do in secret.
- ¹³ But everything exposed by the light becomes visible—and everything that is illuminated becomes a light.
- 14 This is why it is said:

"Wake up, sleeper,

rise from the dead,

and Christ will shine on you."

- Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise,
- making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil.
- Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is.
- ¹⁸ Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit,
- speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit. Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord,

always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.

John 6: 60-69

- ⁶⁰ When many of his disciples heard it, they said, "This is a hard saying; who can listen to it?"
- ⁶¹ But Jesus, knowing in himself that his disciples were grumbling about this, said to them, "Do you take offense at this?
- ⁶² Then what if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where he was before?
- ⁶³ It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh is no help at all. The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life.
- ⁶⁴ But there are some of you who do not believe." (For Jesus knew from the beginning who those were who did not believe, and who it was who would betray him.)
- ⁶⁵ And he said, "This is why I told you that no one can come to me unless it is granted him by the Father."
- ⁶⁶ After this many of his disciples turned back and no longer walked with him.
- ⁶⁷ So Jesus said to the twelve, "Do you want to go away as well?"
- ⁶⁸ Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life,
- ⁶⁹ and we have believed, and have come to know, that you are the Holy One of God."
