We hope you'll join us again next week at 10:30 for worship. Our Sunday School classes start at 9:30 am if you would like to join in on those.




If you have a smartphone, use your phone's camera or code scanner to scan the code.

First Reading

Jeremiah 17: 5-8

- ⁵ This is what the Lord says: "Cursed is the one who trusts in man, who draws strength from mere flesh and whose heart turns away from the Lord.
- 6 That person will be like a bush in the wastelands; they will not see prosperity when it comes. They will dwell in the parched places of the desert, in a salt land where no one lives.
- "But blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord, whose confidence is in 7 him.
- 8 They will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit.

Psalm 1


- L: Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers,
- C: but whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and who meditates on his law day and night.
- L: That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither-whatever they do prospers.
- C: Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away.

- C: For the Lord watches over the way of the righteous, but the of


Second Reading

- 1 Corinthians 15: (1-11) 12-20 Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand.
- ² By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain.
- ³ For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance[a]: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,
- ⁴ that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures.
- ⁵ and that he appeared to Cephas,[b] and then to the Twelve.
- ⁶ After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers and sisters at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep.
- Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles,
- and last of all he appeared to me also, as to one abnormally born. 8
- ⁹ For I am the least of the apostles and do not even deserve to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.
- But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me was not 10 without effect. No, I worked harder than all of them-yet not I, but the grace of God that was with me.
- ¹¹ Whether, then, it is I or they, this is what we preach, and this is what you believed.
- ¹² But if it is preached that Christ has been raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?
- ¹³ If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised.
- ¹⁴ And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith.
- ¹⁵ More than that, we are then found to be false witnesses about God, for we have testified about God that he raised Christ from the dead. But he did not raise him if in fact the dead are not raised.
- ¹⁶ For if the dead are not raised, then Christ has not been raised either. ¹⁷ And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins.
- ¹⁸ Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ are lost.
- ¹⁹ If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied.
- ²⁰ But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep.

¹⁷ He went down with them and stood on a level place. A large crowd of his disciples was there and a great number of people from all over Judea, from Jerusalem, and from the coastal region around Tyre and Sidon,


- ¹⁸ who had come to hear him and to be healed of their diseases. Those troubled by impure spirits were cured,
- ¹⁹ and the people all tried to touch him, because power was coming from him and healing them all.
- ²⁰ Looking at his disciples, he said:
 - "Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God.
 - ²¹ Blessed are you who hunger now, for you will be satisfied. Blessed are you who weep now, for you will laugh.
 - ²² Blessed are you when people hate you, when they exclude you and insult you and reject your name as evil, because of the Son of Man.

Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father, the almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is seen and unseen.

Souper Bowl Update


